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The Degree of The University of Jordan 's Commitment to Promote Awareness of Human Rights Concepts from the Student's Perspective

ABSTRACT

This research aimed at investigating the degree of the University of Jordan's commitment to the promotion of human rights concepts from the student's perspective, and the impact of variables of sex, kind of college and the university year in determining the degree of the university's commitment to strengthen it. A questionnaire consisting (70) statement of seven areas was designed to the study sample consisting of (200) students on purpose taking into account the chance of equal representation for the variables of the study.

The results showed a high degree of commitment of the University of Jordan to promote five areas of rights: the right to belonging and the enjoyment of fundamental freedoms, the right in front of the law, economic rights, rights in education and health, rights to freedom of thought, and religion and belief rights. The research also, showed that the degree of the university's commitment in promoting the right to life, the right to security were medium degree. The results showed no statistically significant differences at the level of significance ($\alpha=0.05$) to the variable sex, also there were significant differences to the variable type of college and the university year for colleges of humanity, and students of the second year, third and fourth, respectively.
