Instructions to Authors

Jordan Medical Journal (*J Med J*) is a peer-reviewed Journal. Authors are invited to submit their work on any topic of wide spectrum coverage including epidemiology, public health, medicine, surgery, pharmacology, nursing, dental, indigenous disease and statements of health care of interest to health care professionals in the region and in the whole world.

Original, unpublished papers undergo a careful peer review before being accepted for publication.

The Editorial Board reserves the right to make the final decision on publication.

The journal publishes several types of papers:

- 1- Original papers presenting the result of full-length studies.
- 2- Invited papers on special topics and literature reviews.
- 3- Review articles. The comprehensiveness of the review, the quality of research and the uniqueness of the topics are used to determine the fitness for publication.
- 4- Case reports with review of the related literature, especially interesting or challenging clinical cases are also accepted. Such papers should have no more than 20 references.
- 5- Editorials, whether written by a member of the Editorial Board or submitted by readers, may be considered.

Submission of manuscripts

Manuscripts are received with the understanding that they are not under simultaneous consideration by another publication. An abstract published prior to a full report is not regarded as a duplicate publication. The authors transmittal letter must accompany the manuscript and contain these statements:

“The manuscript has been approved by all authors involved and is not being published nor being considered for publication elsewhere. The authors transfer all copyrights and ownership to “Jordan Medical Journal.”

Accepted manuscripts should not be published elsewhere without *J Med J* permission.

Manuscript preparation

The format of the *J Med J* complies with “Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts submitted to Biomedical Journals” published by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors in Vancouver, British Columbia, in 1979 (the widely accepted Vancouver Style), as described in the *J Med J* November 1993 (*Jordan Medical Journal*. 1993; 27 (2): 133-147). With the exception of blood pressure, all units of measurement and laboratory values must be expressed in SI units; conventional units may be included parenthetically.

The manuscripts must include tables, references and figure legends, typewritten, double-spaced on 8 ½ x 11 inch or A4 paper, with margins of at least 1 inch. Pages should be numbered consecutively, beginning with the title page. Four original copies of the entire manuscript should be submitted, along with four sets of photographs or/ and figures.

What to submit

1. Cover Letter

The cover letter serves to introduce a submission to the editorial staff. The letter should explain any deviation from the standard format and any potential conflicts concerning the exclusive nature of the paper.

2. Manuscript

Include 4 complete sets of the manuscripts and similar number for photographs or figures. The submission should be typed double-spaced with 1" margins on 8.5" x 11", or A4 paper. The first author's last name should appear after the title page. Manuscripts should not exceed twenty pages, including references, tables and illustrations.

Title

The title page will have the title of the article, the running title, the affiliation of all authors involved, and name and location of the department or institution where the work was performed. Include the corresponding author's name and exact postal address. Manuscripts should include a current e-mail, telephone and fax number. Finally, list any acknowledgments.

The title may not be more than 85 characters long, including spaces, and should properly represent the subject of the manuscript. The running title is 45 characters long, including spaces, and should give a general idea as to the subject of the paper.

Formal Abstract page

For original papers, the abstract page will contain a formal abstract not to exceed 250 words. Do not include abbreviations, footnotes or references in the abstract. The abstract will have four sections. Background Aims will contain the precise purpose of the paper. Materials and Methods will give a brief description of materials used and a concise explanation of the methods. Results will provide a summary of the findings. Conclusions will explain the significance of the work. A summary in Arabic should accompany the manuscript not exceeding (500) words and

should not be a strict translation of the English abstract.

For reviews and case reports, the abstract page will be replaced by a summary page containing a summary not exceeding (200) words in addition to a summary in Arabic not exceeding (200) words.

Keywords

Should be included at the end of the abstract page.

Introduction

The introduction will give brief background information and state the reasons and purposes behind the study.

Materials and Methods

This section must give sufficient information to permit detailed evaluation and duplication of the work by other investigators. Ethical guidelines followed must be described. A statement concerning informed consent must be inserted here if work is done on human subjects.

Approval of institutional human research review committees or animal welfare committees should be placed here.

Results

In this section, report the findings of the work. Use tables and figures where appropriate, to improve the clarity of presentation.

Discussion

Discuss the results in relation to other published works in the same field. Offer explanations for any differences between the presented work and previous efforts. Identify hypotheses and speculations clearly.

References

References must be double-spaced and numbered consecutively as they are cited. References first cited in a table or figure legend should be numbered so that they will be in sequence with references cited in the text at the point where the table or figure is first mentioned. List all authors when there are six or fewer; when there are seven or more, list the first three, followed by “et al.” The following are sample references:

Numbered references to personal communications, unpublished data, or manuscripts either “in preparation” or “submitted for publication” are unacceptable. If essential, such material

can be incorporated at the appropriate place in the text.

Tables

Type the tables double-spaced on separate sheets of 8.5”x11” or A4 paper. Place the table number and title above the table and any explanation notes below the table.

Figure Legends

Type the legends double-spaced on separate sheets of 8.5”x11” or A4 paper. Figures are numbered in order of presentation in the text. The legends should permit interpretation of the figures without references to the text.

Figures

Submit four complete sets of high-quality glossy prints in four separate envelopes. Use only the minimum number of figures required to illustrate a point.

Do not duplicate data already present in the text or tables. Submit the figures in their actual size with label at least 1.5 mm high. The largest size that can be published without reduction is 17.5 cm wide and 22cm tall. Please submit a suggested layout for related figures on a separate sheet of paper. Do not mount figures. Attach a self-adhesive label with the author's last name, the figure number and an arrow pointing to the top, on the back of each figure.

Note: color illustrations are accepted if they make an exceptional contribution to the article. Authors will be required to bare the cost of color figures at cost price.
