Some of the prophetic narrations upon which jurisprudents depend to derive legal/ juridical rules have contained additional sentences or words that do not exist in other narrations in the same subject. The existence of these additions have sometimes led to conclude different legal opinions by jurisprudents, therefore tackling this issue is of high importance. This research aims basically to clarify the meaning, definition, cases and attitudes of Muslim scholars towards these additions. Furthermore, this research highlights the impact of theses additions on creating different legal opinions, with some practical realistic examples and applications from Islamic Jurisprudence.
