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**The End of The Guardianship in The Islamic Jurisprudence.
(A Comparative Study with The Law of the Arabic Personal Affairs)**

ABSTRACT

This paper clarifies how the guardianship ends. Exactly as every beginning has ultimately an end, each contract has also an end. Guardianship begins by accepting the guardian the task of the guardianship, it ends by a variety of matters. The essence of guardianship is to safely keep the underage (minor's) profits and money, then any action that affects this target leads to ending the task, whatever the reason is; such as disposal of guardian, or legally by death of the minor or minor reaching adulthood and be able to take care of his property.

The paper also shows the process of questioning guardian's acts, as such questioning proves the rights and properties of minors to handle the minor and enables him to handle his properties freely and fully. This questioning doesn't mean -by any means- suspecting guardian nor lack of trust. However, it aims to prove the minor's rights, and what the minor owes the guardian. All this should be done before freeing the guardian of his task.
